Director Cowley reported that he and Operator Hansen did the regular well checks. Water quality was good. He feels that the new piping on the standby well is the reason for the better water quality.

Director Cowley also reported that there is a concrete meter box in the pumphouse yard that he and Hansen will install at 5525 Inverness when time and weather permits.

The lead line survey required will be performed in phases. Operator Hansen is aware of this requirement and will get it accomplished with the help of the GM and Director Cowley.

General Manager's Report:

Director Ary suggested we move money from the checking to the LAIF.

Director Cowley reported that no action has been taken on the valve issue due to his recovering from surgery.

New Business:

The customers at 2055 Aberdeen requested a leak adjustment. Their usage was over 80,000 gallons due to the grandkids leaving a hose on. There was discussion that the situation does not exactly qualify under our leak policy but decided to allow their bill to adjusted to the three year average plus an additional amount to help offset the cost of power to pump the water, chlorine for water and labor for Operator Hansen and Director Cowley to investigate, etc.
